The purpose of this research is to learn about the experiences of desisters and detransitioners--specifically, to explore: 1) factors that may or may not be related to the development of and desistance from transgender identification; 2) whether or not individuals experienced changes in their sexual orientation during and after transgender-identification; and 3) what kinds of counseling and informed consent were received by those who sought medical care to transition.

To participate in this research, you must:

- Be 18-33 years of age
- Live in the United States
- Have previously identified as transgender (for at least 6 months)
- Are NOT identifying as transgender now
- Have stopped identifying as transgender at least 6 months ago

Participation in this study includes:

- A screening interview (by videoconference call) to see if you are eligible for the study (15-30 minutes), and
- An online survey about your experiences (60-90 minutes)
